Travel Requirements

Visa Requirements:

- D-2 (Student Visa)
- Students should apply through the Korean Embassy or Korean Consulate in their home countries.

Health Insurance:

Mandatory as listed - Proof of purchase to be submitted before arrival

- Medical benefits of at least \$20,000 per accident or illness (Sickness)
- A deductible not to exceed 20% per accident or illness
- Repatriation of remains in the amount of \$10,000
- Medical evacuation in the amount of \$10,000 in the event the exchange student must be returned to his or her home country due to a serious medical condition
