# **Travel Requirements**

#### Visa Requirements:

• D-2 (Student Visa)

• Students should apply through the Korean Embassy or Korean Consulate in their home countries.

#### **Medical Insurance:**

It is mandatory for all international students studying in Korea to have an insurance that covers medical expenses in Korea

- Medical benefits of at least \$20,000 per accident or illness. (Sickness)
- A deductible not to exceed 20% per accident or illness
- Repatriation of remains in the amount of \$10,000

• Medical evacuation in the amount of \$10,000 in the event an exchange visitor must be returned to his or his or her home country due to a serious medical condition.
