

# **Framework terms and conditions of the “Huawei AI Challenge” competition organized by Huawei Polska sp. z o.o. Warsaw Research Center**

## **§ 1**

### **Competition organizer**

“Huawei AI Challenge” competition is organized by Huawei Polska sp. z o.o., a company specializing in supplying state-of-the-art information and communication technologies (ICT) to customers, businesses and public institutions, with its seat at Domaniewska 39A, 02-672 Warszawa (hereinafter referred to as “Huawei”).

## **§ 2**

### **Goal of the competition**

“Huawei AI Challenge” competition is an international initiative of Huawei, aiming at supporting the development of technological education, adopting it to current market needs and supporting talents among students of technical schools. The competition will enable singling out the most gifted students and offering them knowledge and experience of Huawei experts during workshops and training sessions.

## **§ 3**

### **Location of the competition**

The competition titled “Huawei AI Challenge” is organized in Poland.

## **§ 4**

### **Subject of the competition**

1. Participants who must be students of a higher education institution, must form teams of two or three people (hereinafter referred to as “Team”).
2. Each Team receives a Huawei Mate20 phone on which to design and code an application based on the Huawei HiAI platform, for the period of ca. 3 months.
3. For the duration of the competition, Huawei offers each Team the opportunity for consultations with Huawei experts free of charge. Dates of consultations are stipulated in terms and conditions in §13 Competition schedule.
4. The final result of the Teams’ work will be the presentation of the awarded projects (apps) during the Final Gala which will be held on 13 March 2020. On the day of the presentation, the winners – the best three Teams – will be announced.

## **§ 5**

### **Competition participants**

1. Persons entitled to participate in the competition are students of the first and second cycle studies, both full-time and part-time programs in exact sciences.

## § 6

### Conditions of the participation in the competition

1. Participation in the competition is free of charge.
2. The conditions of the participation in the competition is submitting a competition application to the e-mail address: [Alchallenge@huawei.com](mailto:Alchallenge@huawei.com). The Application form as well as Terms and Conditions will be sent to the Team in response to the submitted application.
3. The application must be complete and contain all required information and documents requested by the Organizer.
4. The work which will result in developing an application must be performed by the Team. At the same time, the developed application must be students' own work – they must not use the help of third persons or available ready fragments of software or scripts (in particular open source software).
5. Students participating in the program must know English at least at a communicative level. It is necessary for their active participation in workshops conducted by Huawei.
6. Applications will be accepted on a first come first served basis, provided they fulfil conditions stipulated in § 5 Competition participants.

## § 7

### Competition Jury

1. The composition of the Jury will be determined by the Organizer – Huawei. Members of the Jury must include experts in electronics, informatics and teleinformatics.
2. The Jury will select the winning Team of the “Huawei AI Challenge” competition before 13 March 2020.
3. In case more than one team receives the same score, the Jury is entitled to conduct additional interviews verifying knowledge and competences of the students, which will be decisive in appointing the winning Team.
4. In case the Team is be unable to collect the award, the award can be collected in the Organizer's seat, after arranging the collection time by e-mail with the Competition Coordinator.
5. Deliberations of the Jury are secret.
6. Decisions of the Jury are binding and final.

## § 8

### Assessment criteria

Mobile apps will be assessed according to the following criteria:

1. complexity and difficulty of the solved problem,
2. description and analysis of the existing solutions and technologies,
3. innovation and originality of the proposed solutions and technologies,
4. functionality of the application.

## § 9

### Submission of the developed works

Ready works (applications) will be submitted by sending them, using a special link, received by each Team's leader in their inbox. The link will be sent together with instructions as to how the work should be correctly submitted. Deadline for submitting works is 09.03.2020 before 16.00.

## § 10

### Prizes

1. The awarded works will be presented during the Final Gala which will be held on 13 March 2020.
2. Prizes will be granted on the basis of assessments made by the Jury appointed by the Organizer. The best three Teams will be announced, and each of their members will receive the following prize:
  - 1st place: each member of the Team will receive a prize of 4000 PLN on an Edenred gift card and a Huawei P30 phone.
  - 2nd place: each member of the Team will receive a prize of 2000 PLN on an Edenred gift card and a Huawei P30 phone.
  - 3rd place: each member of the Team will receive a prize of 500 PLN on an Edenred gift card and a Huawei P30 phone.
3. Teams will be informed of their victory by the Organizer. The winners will receive an additional money prize in the amount of 11.11% of their respective prize, rounded off to the nearest whole zloty, which will be immediately deducted by the Organizer to cover the 10% flat-rate personal income tax for prizes awarded in the Competition (Art. 30 sec. 1 point 2 of the Act on Personal Income Tax) and paid to the relevant Tax Office, to which the Winners agree.

## § 11

### Copyrights

1. Only a work whose exclusive authors are Team members can be submitted for the competition.
2. The application must not constitute a plagiarism or infringe on the rights of third parties or applicable laws in any other way.
3. In the event Team members turn out not to meet aforementioned obligations, the person in question may be charged with full liability for damage caused.
4. Full rights to the created application shall remain with the Authors. Huawei shall be granted a non-exclusive license, unlimited in time and territory, exclusively for the purpose of verifying the submitted work and fulfilling these provisions.

## § 12

### Final provisions

1. Conformity to personal data submitted in the competition application is a condition of receiving the prize.

2. Competition Organizer reserves the right to change this document in writing by way of an annex.
3. All matters not regulated by this document shall be settled by the Organizer.
