

<b>SCHOLARSHIPS FOR MASTER PROGRAMMES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF LUXEMBOURG</b>

The University of Luxembourg is pleased to announce that the Luxembourg Ministry of Culture offers **3 scholarships for the academic year 2014-2015** to Master students of Polish nationality to spend 2 semesters (one academic year) as exchange students at the University of Luxembourg.

**Application requirements:**

- Candidates must be enrolled as regular students with a higher education institution in Poland having signed an interuniversity agreement with the University of Luxembourg (i.e. University of Warsaw, Warsaw University of Technology).
- Students must have completed at least three years of study at their home university at the start of their exchange period at the University of Luxembourg and must be in good standing.
- Students must have sufficient knowledge of the language(s) of instruction of the Master programme they wish to follow at the University of Luxembourg.

**Application files:**

In order to apply for the scholarship, interested candidates **must be nominated by their home university by 5<sup>th</sup> May** at the latest. The nomination shall be sent by the home university to [incoming@uni.lu](mailto:incoming@uni.lu) and [stephanie.schott@uni.lu](mailto:stephanie.schott@uni.lu) and should comprise the following information on the selected student:

- Name and SURNAME
- Gender
- E-mail address
- Citizenship and date of birth
- Study field

The SEVE Mobility office will then send the application form to the student and the coordinator at the home university.

All candidates must submit the following files by e-mail to [incoming@uni.lu](mailto:incoming@uni.lu) and [stephanie.schott@uni.lu](mailto:stephanie.schott@uni.lu) **by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2014** at the latest:

- Completed application form
- Learning agreement signed at the home university (if applicable)
- Identity picture (under JPG format)
- Copy of passport or ID
- Copy of student card/enrollment certificate
- Proof of international insurance covering all risks during the stay in Luxembourg

- Transcript of records of the previous semesters
- Letter of motivation: one page A4, typed, including information on why you wish to study at the University of Luxembourg and why you have chosen the programme that you have selected
- Curriculum vitae

All documents have to be submitted in French, English or German (official translation by the home university or a sworn translator).

**Scholarship conditions:**

The scholarship includes a monthly grant of 500€ over a period of 10 months. In addition, housing costs are covered for the same period.

The exchange period starts mid-September 2014 and ends in June 2015. It is not possible to extend the duration of the grant.
